Moises has always been outstanding for his friendly character. He successfully finished his high school with a degree in hotel and tourism administration.



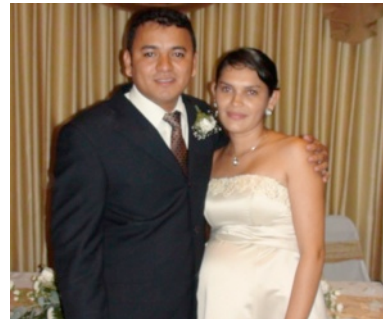
